Dear Parents and Pupils

Welcome back to a new term. Hope everyone had a good Easter. Last term seemed to absolutely fly by. We have a few bank holidays coming up at the start of this term which I hope won't be too disruptive for the Monday modern and tap classes which I am thoroughly enjoying teaching again. Annie will be going to Ibiza to start her new job, we wish her all the best and hope she has a great time. Good luck to all those taking a ballet exam in May, keep up the hard work and keep practicing. There will be exam coaching classes on Sunday 11th May in the Ashford hall so if you are taking an exam you will receive details about this at the beginning of term. If we have enough pupils ready to take exams in the Autumn term then we will have another exam session at the end of October/beginning of November for ballet, tap and modern.

Show I know many of you have been wondering when our next show will be. We have in the past held it in the Autumn however this time I plan to hold it in the Spring of next year. Dates have not yet been fixed and I will do my upmost to avoid any busy GCSE and A level exam times.

<u>Missed Classes</u> I am very happy for pupils who miss a class to make up with a lesson in a different venue if there is an equivalent class. Please text/email first if you wish to do this just to check.

<u>Polling Day Thursday 22nd May</u> My apologies but there will be no classes in Wye (Hannah is involved with manning her local polling station) or Ashford on this day as the hall is used as a polling station.

<u>Crossover Cardigans</u> Now the weather is warming up the crossovers tend go on and off so please could you check it is labeled.

Buns and donuts. The ISTD have sent out a reminder that donuts should not be worn for exams. I have noticed a trend for wearing them in class which, when they were small, was fine but they are getting bigger and bigger and higher and higher finally giving the impression of someone who is about to carry a heavy load upon the top of their head! A classical bun should be on the back of the head. Whilst I'm on the subject of good grooming please also make sure you are not displaying a lot of pant under the line of your leotard, or if you wear a skirt it should be round your waist and not sitting on your hips. If you need a waist elastic (for ballet grades 2 and up) come to me to buy one (£1). Nag over.

Absent or Discontinuing Classes I would like to point out that though we do not insist on a terms notice or a term's fees in lieu of notice as many other schools do, we do expect to be informed well in advance of the beginning of a term if your child will no longer be continuing with us. It is disconcerting for teachers to lose a pupil especially at short notice, plus some classes have waiting lists and spaces can be allocated to others. If you are away from class for two weeks or longer please could you contact your teacher.

<u>Uniform</u> PLEASE have hair tied up and have the correct uniform for class. Make sure you remove watches and jewellery. If you are about to buy a new leotard please make sure you have the correct colour (see below). Please name your child's crossover and shoes. <u>Addresses and Contact Numbers.</u> Please ask for an address card if you have not already filled one out or if you have moved recently.

Uniform for classes:

Ballet: pre-school, primary and grade/level 1- Plum leotard and circular skirt, pink socks or pink tights. Pink leather or canvas

ballet shoes with elastics. Wrap-over cardigans for colder months. Hair up and off the face. **Boys -** White T shirt, black tights of shorts, black or white socks, black ballet shoes.

Grades/level 2 and 3 - Sky Blue leotard with matching belt, pink tights pink leather or canvas ballet shoes. Wrap-over cardigans for colder months. Hair up, preferably in a bun, and off the face. **Boys -** white T-shirt black tights or cycling shorts, white or black socks and black or white ballet shoes. (for exams white socks must be worn with white elastics on shoes).

Grade/level 4 upwards - Black sleeveless or camisole-top leotard, pink tights, pink leather or canvas ballet shoes, pink point shoes (as advised by teacher). Hair up, preferably in a bun, and off the face.

Modern: Black or coloured leotard, footless tights, bare feet. **Tap:** Black or coloured leotard, tights or black jazz pants, black socks and black tap shoes. <u>Hair up and off the face for all classes please</u>.

School Rules: No child is allowed to run around in the hall before class. Please be sure that you sit down quietly at the back of the hall until your teacher calls you.

<u>CHILD PROTECTION ISSUES.</u> As I.S.T.D teachers of dance, we have been advised to issue the following statement in our newsletters to parents: - **Due to the nature of dance training, physical touch of the pupil by a teacher is often necessary.** This would always be clinical and helpful and would never humiliate any pupil.
